

## Who Belongs in the DAV Auxiliary?

- Family and extended family members of veterans who were disabled or died in military service
- Family and extended family members of veterans who have served in the military without sustaining injury
- Family and extended family members of those in active military service
- Family and extended family of Auxiliary members who are not otherwise eligible for membership
- DAV members

Every person who is eligible should belong to the DAV Auxiliary if they believe in protecting the rights of disabled veterans and their families.

## DAV Auxiliary Membership

By joining the DAV Auxiliary, you are lending your voice to our legislative efforts on behalf of all veterans and their families. A life membership can be secured at any age with a \$20 down payment and a flexible membership payment plan. This life membership seals your commitment to the Auxiliary, your veteran and your family.

## Junior Membership

The DAV Auxiliary encourages junior member involvement in all programs of the organization. Learning by example, juniors experience firsthand the rewards of volunteerism and service to the community as well as the significance of honoring our nation's veterans. Children who are age 17 or younger may belong to the Junior Auxiliary. A signature is required from a parent or legal guardian.

Remarkable services offered by the DAV Auxiliary to support veterans and their families include:

- More than **31,280 volunteer hours** at local Department of Veterans Affairs medical centers (\$936,523 value)
- More than **350,000 hours** of community service
- More than **700,000 miles** driven by Auxiliary members
- More than **\$1,508,000** in donations

## Programs Offered

### Service Program

The DAV Auxiliary and service go hand in hand, and all Auxiliary members are prepared to offer assistance when called upon. That's who we are and what we do. Program funding is through a portion of the national mandates and generous donations from members, individuals, units and state departments.

### Caregiver Initiative

The DAV Auxiliary understands the sacrifices not only of those who have or are serving but also of the caregivers—the men and women who have chosen to dedicate their lives for the rehabilitation and recovery of their veteran family member. We have launched the Caregiver Initiative, an ongoing program to enhance the lives of veteran caregivers. Caregivers are not alone, and the DAV Auxiliary will continue to demonstrate the important role they play in the lives of veterans.

### DAVA 4 Kids Grant Program

This program is designed to assist children age 3 through high school senior whose parent or legal guardian is a current service member or a veteran and who have a financial need. It can assist with payments to attend program camps (sports, band, recreational, religious, etc.), participate in extracurricular activities and help with certain extenuating circumstances.

### Education Scholarship Program

The DAV Auxiliary offers an educational scholarship to community members who dedicate their time volunteering for veterans and their families. Program funding is through a portion of the national mandates and generous donations from members, individuals, units and state departments.


### Vocational/Training Assistance Program
